• NEW CLASSROOM CABIN

Alhamdulillah, with your help, we have been able to install an anti vandal 24ft portable classroom. This has allowed us to have all of the primary school children in the first session, and further opportunities for the near future.

• REFURBISHMENT

During the summer holidays we have had new carpets fitted in three classrooms and their adjacent corridor. The three classes have been freshly painted. The outside drains, car park and yard have all been cleaned. We will continue to improve the premises with your support.

• PARENTS EVENING: FRIDAY, 19 OCTOBER 2018

We have changed the date for parents evening closer to half-term rather than after the exams at the end of the term. This allows teachers and parents to discuss progress or concerns in advance before the exams. We believe this is better for our children's development.

• APPEAL: GUTTERING & SECURITY
